The department accepts applications year round whether a position is available or not. Should a position become available the department will screen the existing applicant pool and call the most qualified applicants in for further evaluation.

The information provided in this letter and on the City of Belmont web site (cityofbelmont.org) should guide you in how to properly submit an application.

The application process includes the following steps:

- Interview Board
- Police Officer Physical Ability Test (POPAT)
- Background Investigation
- Medical Physical
- Psychological Testing
- Firearms Qualification
- Captain of Police Interview
- Chief of Police Application Review
- Human Resources Application Review

The following information must be submitted. All forms are on the City of Belmont website.

- F-3 Form
- City of Belmont Application
- Belmont Police Department Release of Information Form (Signed & Notarized)
- Copy of North Carolina Driver's License
- Copy of High School Diploma/GED and or College Diploma if applicable.
- Copy of Social Security Card

Once all forms and information has been gathered please put the information in a sealed envelope. At that time you may drop the application off in person to the front desk or mail it to the department. The application must be marked as follows:
